Good morning Savas,

Thank you for your guidance on our first NEMVCC bid. We are very excited to participate for the first time. We followed the instructions as best we could; if you have any feedback on how to improve our format for next year, please let us know.

Attached you will find two versions of our bid form – one is fully executed with the corporate seal and scanned to my computer. The second is the electronic version which is easier to read, just missing some of the signatures/corporate seal. We are putting the fully executed version in the mail today.

We wanted to call attention to a few items:

- While Transene does not have NSF/AWWA certification yet, we are able to source, store, and deliver NSF/AWWA product. As long as we're not opening or altering the product, the NSF/AWWA certification should pass-through. We bid on 6 items, and per the instructions we do not specify if a product is NSF/AWWA – that is the default. However, as we discussed this winter, we should specify if a product is NOT certified. Some of Transene's bids are for non-water treatment (i.e. wastewater treatment), and non-certified material is acceptable for that application. Without a column for comments/notes, we added notes where appropriate in the blank "unit bid" column. The bids that are not NSF/AWWA certified will say so in this column next to our dollar bid.
- Transene noticed that last year there were no bidders for muriatic acid gallon bottles (Canobie Lake Park). Transene processes muriatic acid every day, but we don't have the NSF/AWWA certificate (yet). However, Canobie Lake Park is not making potable water – they're an amusement park (which we enjoy going to in the summertime). We assume our non-certified muriatic acid is perfect for their application.
- Similarly, anthracite had no bidders last year. Transene has warehouse capacity, and will source, store, and deliver the appropriate material. Just note that our material comes in 50 pound bags instead of 60 pound bags, and it is NSF certified material.

We feel like this is a great start to Transene's inaugural bid. We would be thrilled if we could capture even 1-2 of these 6 items. The Canobie Lake Park muriatic acid opportunity is particularly exciting.




